### HIGHLIGHTS

### \$1,047,775,037 PAYMENTS TO INDIVIDUALS

#### CITIZEN ASSISTANCE

**784,622** payments made to citizens effected by COVID-19 totaling more than **\$826.9M**.\*

#### PAYROLL

The Cherokee Nation utilized **\$220.8M** to ensure no employees were laid off or missed a paycheck.



#### HOUSING

**\$72M** used to assist nearly **16,000** citizens with emergency housing needs.



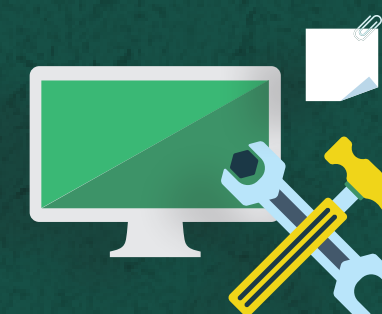
#### JOBS & SMALL BUSINESS

**\$59M** directed toward job placement/training and small business assistance. Over **600** small businesses were assisted in obtaining federal COVID-19 funding.



#### HEALTH CARE

Health Services received an additional **\$293.6M** to combat COVID-19. To date, our healthcare system has administered **369,836** COVID-19 tests and **122,183** COVID-19 vaccines.



#### IMPROVING CONNECTIVITY & EDUCATION

**\$37.9M** invested in improving telework, telehealth, and distance learning.



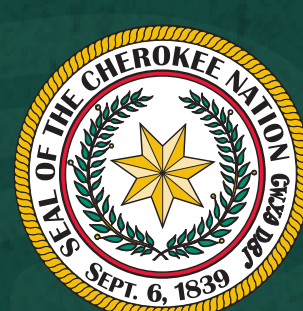
#### FOOD DISTRIBUTION
